ContentEditable

To further simplify the work of sites and frameworks, new types of contentEditable simplifies default behavior to text input only, while providing local-specific information on what a user intends such as to create newlines, delete content, or format it. This allows sites to easily provide their own behaviors without needing to handle complex text input like IMEs.

3. Framing the Problem

- ContentEditable is too complex and buggy to be usable as-is
 While we could solve this by spec'ing contentEditable's behavior, the remaining issues here cause us to look in a new direction instead.
- ContentEditable does not easily enable the wide range of editing scenarios. It is high-level and not supportive of the principles listed in the Extensible Web Manifesto.




For manipulation software, interaction is perfectly suitable: the user views a visual representation of the model, considers what to manipulate next, and performs a manipulation. The software, in turn, inputs the user's manipulation request, updates the model, and displays the updated representation. With good feedback and an effective means of "speaking" to the software, this process can cycle smoothly and rapidly. It mimics the experience of working with a physical tool.




Simple Collaborative Web Pages

Homescreen FramerJS Prototype

This is quick intro example to FramerJS. Layers are the basic containers of Framer, which can contain images, videos, or text. You can position layers with numeric values and dynamic values.



- Layers contain many properties that define their appearance, such as opacity, rotation and scale. Layers can also be nested to adjust their hierarchy.
- To create a layer, use the new keyword. Every layer has a set of default properties: a blue background, and a default width and height of 100.
 - A unique identification number for this layer. No other layer will have this number. The layer id is read only and cannot be changed.
 - The name of a layer. Layers aren't named by default. Imported layers will inherit the name you've defined within Sketch or Photoshop.


